COMMUNITY PLANS CONTINUUM

The Community Plans Continuum (CPC) is an all new system of community planning that will guide local expectations for County services and set a clear direction for the future of each unincorporated community. It will consist of updates to existing plans and the addition of new plans that will be refined regularly to reflect progress and change.
