COUNTYWIDE PLAN

Driven by the Countywide Vision, the Countywide Plan is a comprehensive strategic plan that will guide the County's future. One component of the Countywide Plan is an update and expansion of the County's existing General Plan and Community Plans for the unincorporated areas.

COMMUNITY PLANS CONTINUUM

The Community Plans Continuum (CPC) is an all new system of community planning that will guide local expectations for County services and set a clear direction for the future of each unincorporated community. It will consist of Community Plans/Action Guides that combine with the Policy Plan of the Countywide Plan to act as updates to current plans and to provide new blueprints for additional communities.

The CPC will provide planning and implementation guidance for all unincorporated communities as they pursue their own unique lifestyle choices and aspirations. The CPC will include a hierarchy of planning levels that will ensure that planning details, tools, and resources match the conditions and needs of each community.
